GRADUATION ARRIVAL AND PROCESSION

Doors open one hour before the ceremony start time. Guests of graduates are to be seated 20 minutes before the ceremony start time.

GRADUATES MUST ARRIVE:

Morning Ceremony start time 10am – arrive by 8.45am
Afternoon Ceremony start time 2pm – arrive by 12.45pm

GRADUATION STUDENT ASSEMBLY

Graduates are to assemble at the Wolfbrook Arena one hour before the ceremony starts.

When you arrive, please follow the signs to the graduates' assembly area and:

1. Find the row your department is in (A, B, C, D, E or F)
2. Find the name of your qualification.
3. Find your department sign and the sign on the ground that has your qualification name on it and stand behind it.
4. The marshals will then arrange you in alphabetical order, ready to proceed into the hall.
5. You need to stay to ensure you are ready to cross the stage when your name is called.
6. The Head Marshal will brief you on the details of the graduation ceremony. Then at a signal from the Head Marshal you will move in procession into the hall. Follow the directions of the marshals, who will direct you to your seat.

Don't worry, we will have plenty of signage and friendly staff onsite to ensure you know where to go, and end up in the right place.

CROSSING THE STAGE

1. After the welcome and introductions, you will be called to receive your graduation parchment scroll. Marshals will direct you when to leave your seat.
2. File from your seat to the side of the stage and wait for your name to be checked.
3. When directed by the marshal, proceed across the stage.
4. You will shake hands with two people as you cross the stage.
5. If you are receiving a Bachelor's degree you will be ceremonially capped; you may then place your trencher on your head.
6. Move across to the second person on stage who will hand you a parchment scroll and shake hands with you.
7. Once you have received your parchment scroll, leave the stage down the central steps and return to your seat.

TICKETING / GUEST SEATING

All graduates are entitled to up to **four tickets free of charge** for friends and whanau - you request these when you register for graduation.

Graduation guest tickets will be emailed to you around two weeks before graduation - by 3 March 2026. This email will come from Humanitix (not Ara). Tickets are general admission only.

If you would like to request extra tickets, you can also do this when you register for graduation. We try our best to accommodate these requests, but unfortunately this is not always possible as there is limited availability. Extra tickets will not be confirmed until 3 March, after registration closes (this is so we can ensure all graduates receive their guaranteed tickets).

PHOTOGRAPHY AND LIVESTREAMING

If any of your friends or family are unable to attend your graduation in person, they can watch online as our graduation ceremonies are streamed live on the Ara website on the day.

Ara's graduation ceremonies are filmed for livestreaming, and photographed. Footage and photos will be available publicly on our digital media, and may also be used in Ara publications and promotional materials (digital and print). ACCESSIBILITY

If you or any of your guests have special mobility or access needs, please let us know by contacting us at graduation@ara.ac.nz

If you or any of your guests communicate by NZ Sign Language, we will have an interpreter at the ceremony.

TIPS FOR THE DAY

1. Regalia - ensure you arrive at the venue already dressed and in your regalia.
2. Graduation ceremonies are lengthy so please make sure you're well hydrated and have eaten beforehand. If you feel unwell either before or during the ceremony, just let a staff member know and we can help.
3. Please leave personal items (e.g. handbags, mobile phones, flowers, etc) with your guests during the course of the procession and graduation ceremony.
4. Linton Photography are the official photographers for graduation. Studios will be set up at the venue so you can have portraits taken with family or friends. A limited number of session times are available to book, and sessions are also available on a first come, first served basis before and after your ceremony. Photographs will also be taken of every graduate as they are presented with their award on stage. REGALIA

As part of the formal graduation ceremony, you are required to wear official Ara regalia. If you are not wearing regalia you will not be able to cross the stage.

GWC Regalia Hire own and maintain the regalia for Ara ceremonies and graduates are responsible for ordering their own regalia directly through them. Please [use this link to access the GWC Regalia Hire application form](#) for this graduation ceremony. Please DO NOT use the GWC Casual Hire form.

You must order your regalia by Tuesday 10 March 2026. A late fee will be applied from 1 am on Wednesday 11 March and if you order on the day of graduation which is \$30.

You will receive a confirmation email after your regalia order is placed – if you do not receive this, please check directly with GWC Regalia to ensure that your order has been processed.

Some graduates also add traditional elements such as korowai or ta'ōvala. These may be worn over your academic gown. If you are wearing one of these elements, please request a lighter-weight gown when ordering your regalia.

COLLECTING AND RETURNING REGALIA

You collect your regalia from GWC's premises on the UC Dovedale Campus, Wairarapa Building, Block ED15, Ilam. Parking is in Car Park 1, off Parkstone Ave or Solway Ave.

During graduation season, GWC's hours are extended, and you can collect your regalia anytime between 9am – 7pm on Thursday 12 March. Regalia can be collected on the morning of Friday 13 March 2026 but you must be at the venue by either:
Morning session 8.45am or Afternoon session 12.45pm.

If you are unable to collect your regalia, a family member or friend can collect it on your behalf. However, you **MUST** give your nominated collection person your correct height measurement - and if you are eligible to wear a trencher - your head circumference (measured just above the ears).

Regalia must be returned, in good order, on Friday 13 March (the same day as graduation) – 10am session, regalia to be returned by 3:00pm and 2pm session regalia to be returned by 7pm. Regalia cannot be returned at the venue and must be returned to GWC's premises on the UC Dovedale Campus (same location as collection).

A \$50 security hold will be applied to the card used to purchase the regalia hire with GWC. If you cannot provide this amount at check-in you will not be able to collect your regalia. This security hold cannot be paid in cash. The security hold will show as a pending transaction and will automatically 'drop off' after 7 days, once it's been confirmed that the regalia was returned undamaged within the above timeframe.

After 13 March, the GWC Regalia Hire opening hours go back to standard hours which are Tuesdays and Thursdays 9.30am – 2.30pm.

Penalties for non-return of regalia

A family member or friend can return regalia on your behalf. Please be aware if regalia is not returned you will be charged at replacement cost which is:

REGALIA REFUND POLICY

If you notify Ara that you are withdrawing from your Graduation ceremony by Friday 6 March, you will receive a full refund of your regalia hire costs minus a \$10 administration fee. However, in the event you do not collect your regalia and do not let us know in advance, there are no refunds.

If you are prevented from attending graduation at the last minute due to illness or travel disruption, you can hire your regalia for photos or a private ceremony at another time.

REGALIA ITEMS

Gown

A black, Cambridge-style gown is worn under the Ara graduation scarf or hood. The sleeves on the Cambridge gown have two openings:

- graduates for a certificate, diploma or degree that have no previous degree use the lower opening
- any graduate with a previous degree, new degree, graduate certificate, graduate diploma, postgraduate or Masters use the higher opening

Diploma and certificate scarf

A diploma scarf (dark teal) is worn by graduates receiving diplomas and a certificate scarf (light teal) is worn by graduates receiving certificates.


Degree hood

The degree hood incorporates an Ara diploma scarf. The hood is worn with the scarf sitting on the shoulders and the hood hanging down the wearer's back.


Hood lining colours





The progress bar at the top of the page will show which step you are currently on during the ordering process.



Confirm Regalia

Add your gown and hat measurements.

i IMPORTANT

If you are collecting your regalia in person, your gown and hat will be fitted correctly to you while you are at our premises. You can have someone collect on your behalf. Please ensure you have accurately filled in your head and height measurements. This will help avoid the need to return to our premises for item exchanges.

i Gown Measurement

Please enter your full height in centimetres. When you receive your confirmation email, the height may differ as our system will adjust it to fit our gown size range.

i Hat Measurement

If you are collecting your regalia in person you do not need to measure your head. However, if someone else is collecting on your behalf, download our sizing guide and correctly measure your head. The hats are a rigid fit and approximate measurements are not sufficient.

i Higher Qualification

If you are graduating with a certificate or diploma but hold a higher degree, you can submit proof of your qualifications to upgrade your regalia order to include a hat and a bachelor's or master's gown. This is part of the 'Details & Payment' step of our order form (Step 7d).






If Something Goes Wrong

I didn't receive an email?

Please check your bank account to confirm whether the funds have been withdrawn. If they have, it's possible that you entered your email address incorrectly. Please get in touch with us via email with the correct email address so that you can receive all relevant information regarding the graduation process. If the funds have not been withdrawn, your order was unsuccessful due to an issue with your payment details or insufficient funds. In this case, you will need to restart the ordering process. Your order details should still be available unless you cleared your cache.

The form won't let me move to the next stage, what should I do?

Please make sure that you have filled in all the required fields and checked the appropriate boxes on your order. If you have done this and it still doesn't work, we recommend trying a different browser or using another device to enter your information. If you have already tried both of these options and are still experiencing issues, please contact us during our business hours for assistance.

Why doesn't my qualification come with a hat?

Not all qualifications are eligible for a hat. If you are completing a diploma or a certificate, you will not receive a hat unless you already have a higher degree, such as a bachelor's, master's, or PhD. Additionally, if you are graduating with a qualification based on recognition of prior learning and you do not have any other qualifications, you will not wear a hat, even if others in your cohort do.

Where are you located?

If your order was successfully submitted and payment has been received, and you entered your email address correctly, you will receive an email a few days before graduation week with an attached map to help you find us. If you do not receive this email, it is possible that you entered your email address incorrectly. In this case, please contact us via email or phone, and we can update your order.

If you encounter any issues or have a question that is not answered in our [FAQ](#) here or on our website or the full terms of hire, please contact us via email, as we are not in the office every day.

Alternatively, you can find us by searching for "GWC Regalia Hire" on Google, where we have uploaded a map in the images section to assist you in locating us on the UC Dovedale Campus.

I didn't receive a QR code, can I still collect?

Yes, you can still collect your order. Your order may not have been submitted successfully, or your email address is entered incorrectly. The QR code simply makes it easier to locate your order, however, if your order was successful, we will be able to find you.

Can I collect my regalia early?

Unfortunately, early collection is not possible. The period leading up to graduation is quite hectic as we work to ensure that all regalia is prepared for both students and staff. Our volunteers are not available every day, and unless there are exceptional circumstances, we cannot accommodate this request.

Why do I have to return my regalia on the same day as graduation?

We allow a few hours after the ceremony for celebration and photos, but we do ask that regalia be returned while our volunteers are still on site. This is important so they can efficiently process the high volume of returns for the upcoming ceremonies. Even if your ceremony is the last one of the graduation, our volunteers have dedicated their time to help manage these returns. Failure to return your regalia on time means your security hold will be collected as a consequence.

Can I have the regalia for a longer period for photos or a family event?

We allow students 2 to 3 hours after the ceremony to take photos with family members at their institution and with their qualification certificates before the evening celebrations begin. If you require more time for a special event, please contact us. The extension will depend on the size of the graduation, the timing of your ceremony, and the reason for needing the regalia longer. Please note that if you do not inform us, you may face your security hold being collected for returning the regalia late.

Autumn Graduation – Checklist
