


Accessing O'Reilly Ebooks


Immediate access to O'Reilly Ebooks

1. Go to **My Ara**: <https://myara.ara.ac.nz/>
2. Click on **Primo Library Search**
3. Click on **Databases**
4. Find **O'Reilly Ebooks** in the A-Z list and click the link.
[At "**Select Institution**" choose "**Not listed? Click here**"]
5. Sign in using your student email address and click "**Let's go**" e.g.


6. The website should respond "**Welcome to the O'Reilly Learning Platform!**". Click on "**Got it**". This gives you immediate access for up to 3 days.

Set up an O'Reilly Account

1. Complete your account set up, by going to your student email account to look for an email from O'Reilly that includes a unique link and prompt for you to set up your personal account. We recommend you use your network / Moodle password for your O'Reilly account.

2. Then repeat steps 1 - 4 and click on **“Already a user? Click here”**

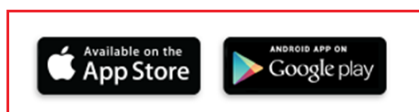

Set up the O'Reilly mobile app if preferred

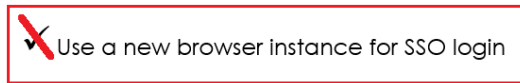
Download the Safari app to your smartphone or tablet by doing the following:

a. Go to your App store and search for **O'Reilly Media Inc.**

b. Click on the appropriate app for your device

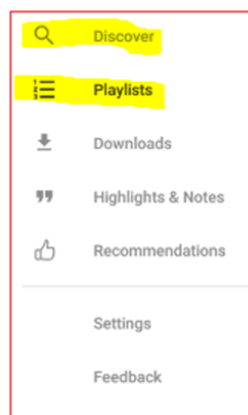


- c. Use your student email address and the password you set up in the previous steps and make sure that the following box is **NOT** ticked before you click on **Sign in**.



- d. Click the Hamburger menu in the top left and click

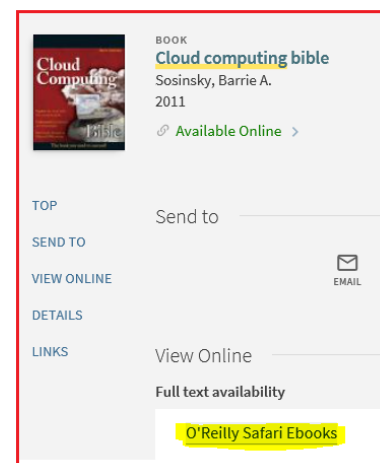
- **Discover** to find book titles
- **Playlists** to create lists of your favourite titles



Accessing O'Reilly Ebooks from the Library Search

Once you have set up your O'Reilly ebook account you can also access the ebooks via the Library Search.

Click on "**O'Reilly Ebooks**" under **View Online**, and use your student email address and the password you set up in the previous steps if prompted.
